



# Logging in to the gateway

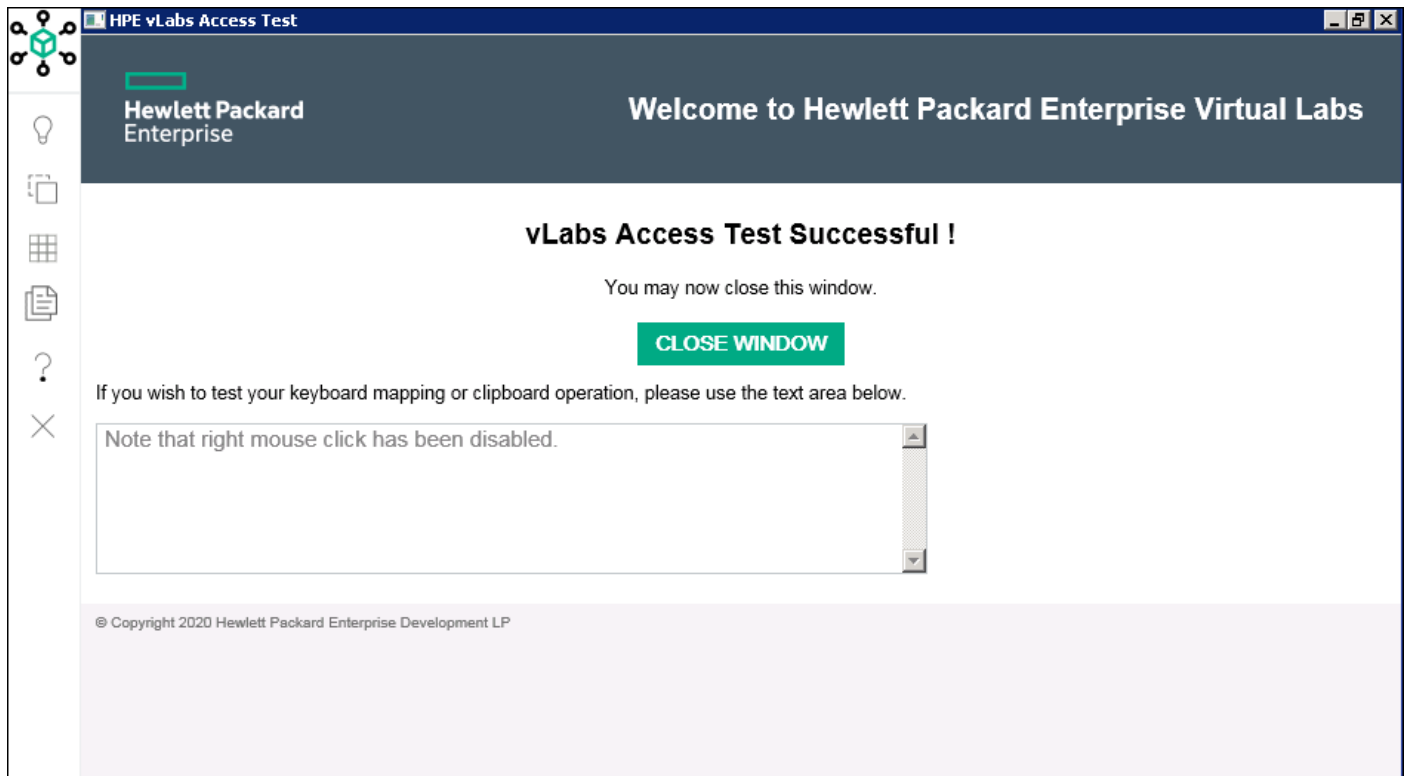


If you are not already logged in to the HPE OnePass portal, you will be redirected to do so. Provide your HPE OnePass username & password at the prompts and you will be redirected back to the vLabs gateway where you will enter your username, given by your instructor or received via email. If you do not have a HPE OnePass login, you will be able to create one at this stage. Please make your keyboard selection if it differs from the default.

2. Enter **vlabtest** into the Username field...
3. Select your keyboard type if it differs from the default and click Enter Course.



4. Upon successful login, you will see the following screen:



Use the text area to practice copy and paste operations as these are slightly different when using the HTML5 interface, as outlined in the [User Guide](#).

5. To complete the pre-course test:

- Click the “Close Window” button to exit the lab. You may now close your browser and test another if required.
